SUBJECT: CCPD POLICY 313.4 SEARCH PROTOCOL

INTRODUCTION:

This General Order was created to notify all department personnel of changes to the department's policy 313.4 – Search Protocol

DESCRIPTION:

- (F) When an employee/Officer must conduct a search of an individual they have reason to believe is transgender or non-binary, the transgender or non-binary individual shall be asked their preference concerning the gender of the member searching them. For example, "What gender employee/Officer would you prefer to search you?" If the transgender or non-binary individual's request can be reasonably and expeditiously accommodated without risk to employee/Officer safety, the request should be granted.
 - 1. If a member of the transgender or non-binary individual's preferred gender is not available, the search can be conducted by the employee/Officer on scene.

2.

- (a) The search of a transgender or non-binary individual shall be conducted with a witness employee/Officer present.
- (b) When feasible, employees/Officers shall obtain Supervisory approval prior to conducting a search of a transgender or non-binary individual.
