Suspects Arrested for Two Armed Robberies During Commission of a Third

On 04/11/21, between 0450 and 0505 hours, two separate armed robberies occurred in Culver City (4436 Sepulveda Blvd. & 11001 Washington Blvd.) at two 7-Eleven locations. During both robberies, two male subjects armed with a handgun and rifle entered the stores and held the clerks at gunpoint while stealing money and other miscellaneous items. After the commission of both crimes, the suspects were able to flee the scene prior to officers' arrival.

After the second robbery, Culver City Police Officers checked nearby 7-Eleven locations and witnessed two male subjects holding the store clerk at gunpoint at the 7-Eleven located at 10356 Venice Blvd, in LAPD Pacific Division's jurisdiction. Upon seeing the officers, the suspects fled to the rear of the store, while the clerk safely fled through the front doors. Culver City Officers established a perimeter containing the suspects within the store and called LAPD. LAPD Officers arrived, assumed responsibility of the scene, and ultimately took both suspects into custody without incident.

Both suspects were positively identified and arrested for the robberies.
