FIREARMS PROFICIENCY MARKSMANSHIP AWARDS

INTRODUCTION:

This General Order was created to notify all department personnel of changes to the department's 1021.9.9 -Uniform Accessories guidelines. This will allow for sworn personnel to wear the updated department approved marksmanship pins on their uniform. Qualified personnel may wear this medal on the lower right corner of their left shirt pocket of their duty uniform only.

DESCRIPTION:

This firearms proficiency marksmanship award is a silver circular disk 1" in diameter with either no accent, navy, or navy and white accents; a pair of silver color crossed pistols are encircled by a designation band inscribed "MARKSMAN, SHARPSHOOTER, AND EXPERT" atop and "CULVER CITY PD" below.

AWARD ELIGBILITY:

The <u>Marksman</u> firearms proficiency pin is awarded to sworn personnel achieving a score of 92-95 for two consecutive Department Record Qualifications on their first attempt, with their primary handgun, in a level II or higher duty holster. Qualification scores obtained during individual qualifications for personally owned firearms that occur outside of the official Department Record Qualifications are not considered for this award.

The <u>Sharpshooter</u> firearms proficiency pin is awarded to sworn personnel achieving a score of 95-99 for two consecutive Department Record Qualifications on their first attempt, with their primary handgun, in a level II or higher duty holster. Qualification scores obtained during individual qualifications for

personally owned firearms that occur outside of the official Department Record Qualifications are not considered for this award.

The <u>Expert</u> firearms proficiency pin is awarded to sworn personnel achieving a score 100 for two consecutive Department Record Qualifications on their first attempt, with their primary handgun, in a level II or higher duty holster. Qualification scores obtained during individual qualifications for personally owned firearms that occur outside of the official Department Record Qualifications are not considered for this award.
